Frank S. Mathers

In 1956, his ninth season as a professional hockey player, Frank Mathers moved to Hershey to rejuvenate the HERSHEY BEARS. Over the next six seasons he played and coached the BEARS to two Calder Cup Championships. In 1962 Mathers hung up his skates, but continued to coach. The next 11 seasons Mathers led the way behind the bench and captured another Calder Cup. Before retiring in 1991, as President and General Manager of the BEARS, he won three more Calder Cups. In 1987, Mathers received the Lester B. Patrick award for service to hockey in the United States. Then in 1992, he was granted the highest honor: being inducted into the Hockey Hall of Fame. Mathers will forever be, Mr. HERSHEY BEARS Hockey.
